Items Discussed

- Update on decorations. This work is still not complete, with unpainted doors, missing skirtings and carpeted areas still requiring attention. The Committee members are disappointed that this work is no further forward despite assurances from Freshwater that it is 'in hand'. PA is to write again to Julian Keen at Freshwater to ask for a definitive completion date.
- TM has arranged a visit to the HSBC bank to update the signatories list for the Residents' Association bank account.
- Rushcliffe Borough Council has yet to make a decision on the request for planning permission to extend the number of cars stored on the site of the Trentside Social Club. The Committee members suggested that those residents who overlook the site, and are therefore most affected by the noise, to consider lobbying the Council to speak against the proposal. This can be done either in writing or on line.
- Freshwater has been informed of the anti-social behaviour of certain tenants who are in breach of their contracts because of excessively noisy activity, particularly between the hours of 11pm and 7am. Tenants should be aware that continued anti-social behaviour can lead to eviction!!
