- The organisers of the Robin Hood Marathon will consult with the Rivermead Residents Association prior to next year's event to ensure that the event is planned better and is less disruptive.

- There has been a delay with works commencing on the handrails on the staircases, this is due to issues with the contractor, it is currently unknown as to when the works will commence.
- Linda is currently off work on long term sickness and a colleague in the Freshwater office has retired recently so work to update the handbook hasn't been carried out, however it's hoped to get this up and running in November.
